Children's String Ensemble

CSE is an all-volunteer-run music group providing children with near-free violin or cello music lessons. CSE uses worship music repertoire as it's teaching material in conjunction with a popular form of instrument lesson plan known as the Suzuki Method. 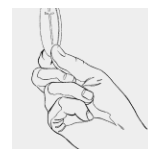
