## Did You Know? Protecting children from Abuse

### Bullying Is a Form of Abuse

Did you know that bullying is a form of abuse, and therefore is forbidden in our Catholic schools? Bullying typically consists of direct behaviors, such as teasing, taunting, threatening, hitting, shoving and stealing. But it might also be indirect, such as spreading rumors that cause victims to be socially isolated through intentional exclusion. Cyberbullying, which involves the use of the Internet or mobile phones to send inappropriate messages and images to or about others, is also behavior that is not tolerated in our Catholic schools. If you suspect bullying of a child at school, please contact the school principal with your concerns.

Over the summer, Our Lady of the Assumption has implemented a community meal service known as Many Meals. The pilot program has been successful so far and continues to grow each week. As a reminder, Many Meals is a program which provides a well-balanced, home cooked meal and friendly companionship to anyone needing to stretch their budget or wishing to share a meal with friends. Dinner is free of charge and served every Monday evening in Assumption Hall.

The program operates much like a café/restaurant with our volunteer crews preparing and delivering food items, setting up the hall, managing parking lot security, guest and volunteer check-in, running the kitchen, providing food and guest service as well as cleaning up and breaking down. It is a truly happy group of people who strive to make each and every guest feel welcome and loved!

Through the hard work and dedication of these many volunteers, we have been able to serve a variety of different people including but not limited to young families, senior citizens, singles, homeless individuals, and OLA parishioners. It has been a joyful and humbling experience to watch our enthusiastic volunteers embrace this ministry and to feel God's presence through the expressions of gratitude among our guests. If you have not yet had the opportunity to attend Many Meals either as a guest or volunteer, we highly encourage you to stop by.

Many Meals is a self-supporting non-profit organization, associated with, but financially separate from the church itself. As such, we rely heavily on the generosity of our volunteer base to provide all the food items and service personnel for each meal. There are also some operational costs such as food service equipment, paper products, office supplies and restaurant apparel associated with the program for which monetary donations are gratefully accepted and appreciated.
